Get your taxes done for free **AND** the **entire** refund due to you by calling one of The Cuyahoga Earned Income Tax Coalition FREE tax preparation sites. The CEITC has organized expert volunteer tax-preparers at 38 sites around Cleveland where you can get **FREE tax preparation**. Some nearby sites are Merrick House West, 3167 Fulton Road, 281-4212, Old Brooklyn NFSC 4261 Fulton Parkway, 987-6620, Spanish American Committee, 4407 Lorain Avenue, 961-2100, and 35 other neighborhood centers. You can call any of these to make an appointment OR call First Call for Help by dialing 211, to ask for the Cuyahoga County Free tax preparation sites.

**The 2010 Census – A Great Way to Earn Extra Money:** The U.S. Census Bureau is recruiting temporary part-time census takers for the 2010 Census. The pay is good, the part-time hours are flexible, and the work is close to home. Thousands of census takers are needed to update address lists and conduct interviews with community residents. Most positions require a valid driver's license and use of a vehicle with mileage reimbursement. However, public transportation may be authorized in certain areas. Bilingual speakers are encouraged to apply! All census takers must be able to speak English, but bilingual skills in English and other languages are needed in communities that have a large number of residents who speak a language other than English.
