CONFIRMATION WILL BE ON SUNDAY, JUNE 7TH AT 10:00 MASS AT OUR LADY OF LOURDES CHURCH AT EAST 55th AND BROADWAY.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is the third of the sacraments of initiation into the Catholic Church. Baptism celebrates our membership in the Family of God. Communion or the Eucharist celebrates our loving communion with God and God's family, living and dead. Confirmation celebrates that we are sent forth as Jesus was sent forth by God into the world in the power of the Spirit of God. With Jesus and his whole family, we are to be **priests**, making an everlasting gift of ourselves to God; we are to be **prophets**, speaking the message of Jesus for God in the world; and we are to share in the **kingship** of Christ, using all the power he gives us to serve one another and the poor of the world.

Most recently, many pastors in the Diocese are requiring that persons be confirmed who wish to be godparents or sponsors or who wish to be married in the Church. If there are adults or young adults in your extended family who wish to be confirmed, they should obtain a copy of their Baptismal certificate from the church of Baptism and arrange to come to **one of two classes** that we will conduct in the Rectory meeting room on **Sunday, May 3rd at 2:00 PM and Sunday May 24th at 2:00 PM**. Please call the Parish Office to make a reservation or to make other arrangements.

Homestead Exemption Property Tax Reduction Program

◇ If you are at least 65 years old or will reach age 65 anytime during the current tax year; or the surviving spouse (age 59-64) of a homestead recipient at the time of the spouse's death; or ◇ if you are totally and permanently disabled as of January 1 of the filing year; and ◇ own or reside in the home or manufactured home as their primary residence as of January 1 of the filling year. Some homeowners may have met all the qualifications last year, but were not aware of the program. Please know that they are eligible to file as a late filer for 2007 by making the box (late application) for the prior year. If you meet the requirements please feel free to take an application from the tables in the back of the Church. Make sure they are sent in before **June 1,2009**.
