**CONFIRMATION WILL BE ON SUNDAY, JUNE 7, AT 10:00 MASS
AT OUR LADY OF LOURDES CHURCH AT EAST 55th AND
BROADWAY.**

The Sacrament of Confirmation is the third of the sacraments of initiation into the Catholic Church. Baptism celebrates our membership in the Family of God. Communion or the Eucharist celebrates our loving communion with God and God's family, living and dead. Confirmation celebrates that we are sent forth as Jesus was sent forth by God into the world in the power of the Spirit of God. With Jesus and his whole family, we are to be **priests**, making an everlasting gift of ourselves to God; we are to be **prophets**, speaking the message of Jesus for God in the world; and we are to share in the **kingship** of Christ, using all the power he gives us to serve one another and the poor of the world.

Most recently, many pastors in the Diocese are requiring that persons be confirmed who wish to be godparents or sponsors or who wish to be married in the Church. If there are adults or young adults in your extended family who wish to be confirmed, they should obtain a copy of their Baptismal certificate from the church of Baptism and arrange to come to **our Confirmation Class** in the Rectory meeting room on **Sunday May 24th at 2:00 PM**.
