Liturgical Reflection: In today's Gospel reading, as Jesus sends the disciples into the towns to announce liberation for "the poor" and to teach them of God's love, he instructs them to do a ministry of **caring and compassion**.

At the end of Matthew's Gospel (ch. 28, vs. 19 and 20), Jesus will send the disciples into the world as the Father sent Him: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always until the end of the age."

And so we are sent to teach what he commanded that we "love one another as He loves us!"
