VIRTUS training is required for any volunteer at the Parish who will be working with children. A complete list of training programs at Parishes around the Diocese during the month of September is available at <http://virtus.org> as well as online registration. A printed list for your consultation is in the Sacristy...it is 17 pages long so please leave the list in the Sacristy once you've looked at it.

For all of you who have already taken VIRTUS training, we want to make sure that you are enrolled online for the updates and that your file is up to date with the Diocese. If you've taken training in the past, PLEASE CALL EILEEN KELLY AT THE PARISH OFFICE TO MAKE SURE THAT YOU ARE REGISTERED WITH THE DIOCESE. This is important because we must find you on the "Virtus Registered" list before you can volunteer with our programs for children. 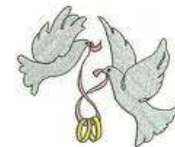
