VIRTUS training is required for any volunteer at the Parish who will be working with children. If you are planning to help with PSR, our new Pre-School of Religion, or any other program that involves any contact with children, you must take VIRTUS training before you start. A complete list of training programs at Parishes around the Diocese during the month of September is available at www.virtus.org as well as online registration. A printed list for your consultation is in the Sacristy...it is 17 pages long so please leave the list in the Sacristy once you've looked at it.

Beginning in October we hope to start a Pre-School of Religion for children 3 to 5 years old and an early childhood program with First Communion training for children grades one to three. The program will begin at 10:30 AM on Sunday mornings and will continue through the 11:00 AM Mass. We are accepting registrations for children in this age group. Volunteers who wish to help with teaching and or assisting are welcome. If you are able to help, please call the Parish Office.

For all of you who have already taken VIRTUS training, we want to make sure that you are enrolled online for the updates and that your file is up to date with the Diocese. If you've taken training in the past, PLEASE CALL EILEEN KELLY AT THE PARISH OFFICE TO MAKE SURE THAT YOU ARE REGISTERED WITH THE DIOCESE. This is important because we must find you on the "Virtus Registered" list before you can volunteer with our programs for children.
