### **VIRTUS: PLEASE NOTE:**

**We have scheduled a VIRTUS training at St. Colman's next Saturday, 10:00 a.m. in Room 26 of the School.** If you'd like to attend, please register online at [www.virtus.org](http://www.virtus.org) (look for the training under Cleveland, OH, St. Colman) or call the Parish Office. Registration is limited to 50 people, so please register right away.

**VIRTUS** training is required for any volunteer at the Parish who will be working with children. If you are planning to help with PSR, our new Pre-School of Religion, or any other program that involves any contact with children, you must take VIRTUS training before you start. **If you cannot attend the training at St. Colman's next Saturday**, a complete list of training programs at Parishes around the Diocese during the month of September is available at [www.virtus.org](http://www.virtus.org).
